

UETDRMP018 PERFORM RESCUE FROM A LIVE LOW VOLTAGE (LV) PANEL COURSE

This course equips learners with practical skills and knowledge necessary for safe rescue of a casualty who has sustained injuries while working on low voltage conductors or equipment, in compliance with the 'Electrical Safety Regulation 2002' and 'Queensland Electrical Safety Act 2002'.

Course Delivery & Duration

First Aid Action provide a Learner's Manual (both online & PDF) along with mandatory pre-course study requirements. This study reduces the face-to-face training which you should allow 2.5 hours for completion. The course is delivered in English and requires students to be competent communicating in English (written and verbal).

Course Content

- Identifying hazards, assessing risks and applying control measures
- Fitting of rescue personal protective equipment (PPE)
- Identifying, analysing and evaluating potential risks that may arise
- General principles and techniques of a rescue
- Effectively extricate individuals from dangerous or emergency situations
- Low Voltage Switchboard Rescue Procedures
- Assessment, first aid, and medical treatment of burns
- Techniques and procedures used to control bleeding in the event of an injury.

Pre-Requisites

All students must provide an original photo identification or equivalent and enrolment needs to be completed by the student (with office support, where required).

Pre-requisite unit

- Previously, many training organisations required HLTAID009 (Provide CPR) as a prerequisite.
- Now, HLTAID009 content is usually embedded in UETDRMP018, so no separate prerequisite is mandated under training.gov.au.

Certification
